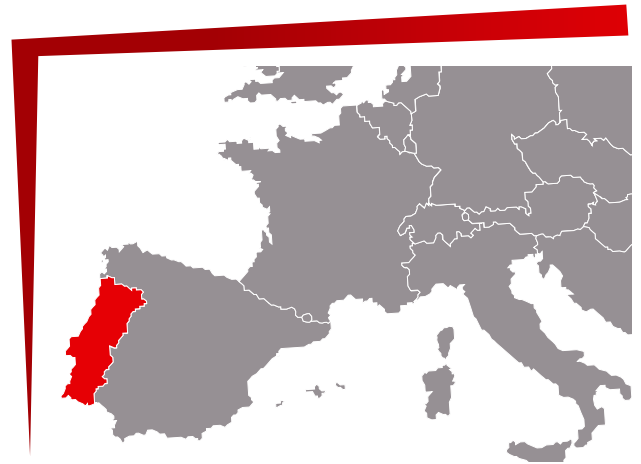

LOCATION _ Portugal is located on the west side of the Iberian Peninsula, ideally positioned between Spain and the Atlantic Ocean. Portugal's excellent geographical position makes it a stopover point for many foreign airlines at airports all over the country. Portugal has 5 international airports: Lisbon, Oporto, Faro, Funchal (Madeira) and Ponta Delgada (Azores). With beautiful beaches, vineyards, sophisticated cities, country inns and palaces, Portugal invokes a romantic notion of breathtaking scenery, rich history and cobble-stone roads. With such a long sea coast, Portugal has a long term tradition with the water and with water sports, such as Canoeing.

LANGUAGE _ One of the Latin languages, Portuguese is the third most spoken European language in the world and the native tongue of about 200 million people. The Portuguese-speaking countries are scattered all over the world. Portuguese is spoken in Europe (Portugal), in Africa (Angola, Cape Verde, Guinea-Bissau, Mozambique and São Tomé e Príncipe), in South America (Brazil) and in Asia, (East Timor, the youngest nation in the world). In Portugal, a considerable number of citizens can communicate in English, French and Spanish.

CLIMATE _ Portugal has a sunny climate. There are only slight fluctuations in temperature between summer and winter; the overall mean ranges from 25°C in summer to about 14°C in winter. The rainy season begins in November and usually lasts through January. Portugal has 220 days of sun and 3000 hours of sunshine every year!



► Montemor-o-Velho

The event will take place in Montemor-o-Velho, Portugal



Montemor-o-Velho (Portuguese pronunciation) is a town and municipality of the Coimbra district, in Portugal. It has roughly 30,000 inhabitants.

Montemor-o-Velho, which was once a land of farmers, is now facing the tertiary sector activities, partly due to the installation of governments offices, financial institutions and services; such as small traders. The industry is represented by several manufacturing plants of small and medium size.

Agriculture continues to have great importance. People grow maize and rice using increasingly modern processes. The existence of a Vocational Agricultural School, together with the Cooperative and the services of the Agricultural Zone DRABL, contribute to technical expertise that improves the productivity of the fields.

The city of Montemor-o-Velho is the co-organizer of the 2015 ICF Canoe Sprint World Cup I, in partnership with the Portuguese Canoe Federation.



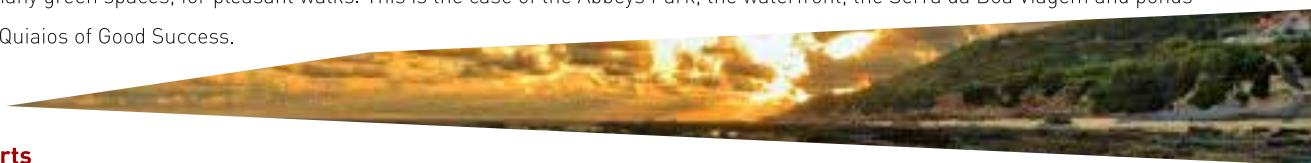
► Figueira da Foz

The city of Figueira da Foz is located on the Atlantic coast of Portugal, in the Central Region, only 18 kilometers from Montemor-o-Velho.

The sun and the beach are its main tourist resources. Linked by about 4 km of fine golden sand and a sea multifaceted, offering all the attractions for a relaxing holiday, fun and enjoyable. The animation is a constant throughout the afternoon and evening of Figueira da Foz, turning the streets into magical moments of joy and color.

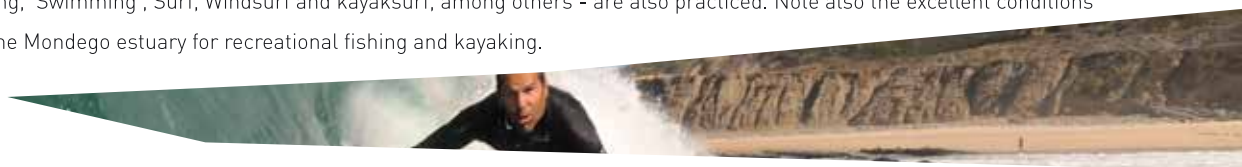
The Nature

One of the charms of Figueira da Foz is the beach with its striped wooden bars and extent of soft white sand. Known as "Beach Clarity", this vast beach it was preferred in the late nineteenth century by the aristocratic class. Figueira da Foz can also be proud of its many green spaces, for pleasant walks. This is the case of the Abbeys Park, the waterfront, the Serra da Boa Viagem and ponds and Quiaios of Good Success.



Sports

Natural conditions invite the practice of many sports. Beyond Mundialito Beach Soccer, held in July and August, water sports, like Powerboating, Swimming, Surf, Windsurf and kayaksurf, among others - are also practiced. Note also the excellent conditions offered by the Mondego estuary for recreational fishing and kayaking.



Culture

Figueira da Foz has a rich historical heritage: The Municipal Museum with Dr. Santos Rocha vast collection (collections of archeology, ethnography African and Oriental numismatics, painting, sculpture, ceramics and furniture), a collection of Delft tiles (House of Palace), the numerous churches with their golden carvings, the Sotto Mayor Palace, the Palace of Mallorca, the Fort of Santa Catarina and the Fortress of Buarcos, archaeological remains. Figueira da Foz is the life of a people, the history of a region and the pleasure of discovery of her past. The recent construction of the Performing Arts Center and came to give it national notoriety since passed here to perform many of the programs that only happened in Lisbon and Porto. With a room with capacity for 800 people and one of the largest stages in the country, CAE, has numerous exhibition halls and a small auditorium equipped with the latest technologies and sound.



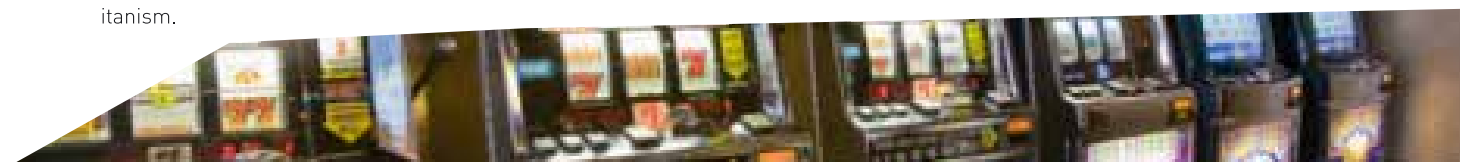
Traditions

Despite the social changes brought about by the progress, Figueira da Foz keeps alive the oldest traditions such as the famous handicrafts or their popular festivities. More recently, the City of Festivals, held on June 24, are also an important milestone in the life of the county.



Night

The night of Figueira da Foz has two personalities a more peaceful and romantic one and a more lively and social. One day you can feel like a pleasant stroll by the river or streets of the old town, another one you may opt for a trip to the Casino, which also offers shows and varieties, or even for a night of socializing in many of its bars, clubs and terraces, that dot this city already known for its cosmopolitanism.



► Airports

Getting here by air. Portugal has two major International Airports

Oporto airport: The Francisco Sá Carneiro Airport is located in the heart of the industrial north of the country, 11km from the city of Oporto, making it a privileged access point to this valuable commercial area.

It is less than 150km away from the Venue in Montemor-o-Velho. The travel time by bus is around 1 hour and 30 minutes.



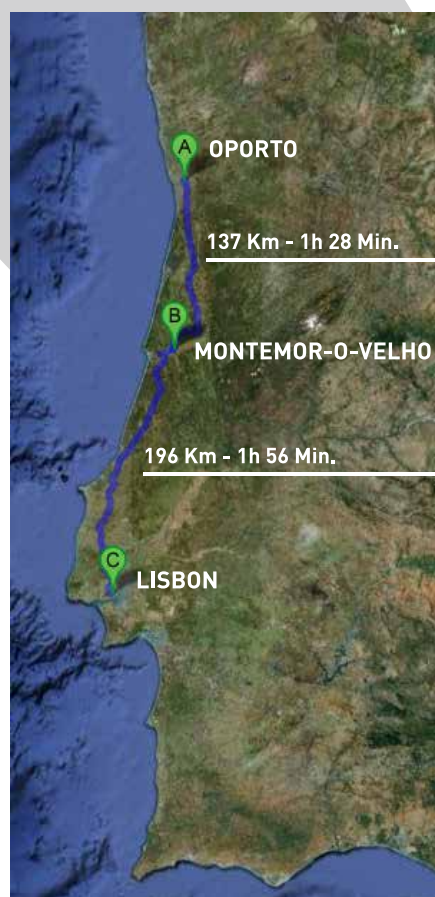
The Lisbon Airport, providing service to the capital of Portugal, is the busiest and most important airport in the country and the principal point of entry for travellers arriving in Portugal. There is a connection to the city centre and interface with Railway Stations by aero shuttle and bus. The train also connects Lisbon to Coimbra and then to Montemor-o-Velho. Both airports receive daily flights from low cost companies like ryanair and easyjet, among others, from all over Europe cities.

The organization will provide airport transfers from Oporto to the Hotels for a fee of 35 euros per person, including return trip. If your team arrives to Lisbon we could also provide you transfer to the official Hotels, for a fee of 45 euros per person, including return trip. The distance from Oporto to the Accommodation city (Figueira da Foz) is around 150km. From Lisbon it's a longer trip, with a total of 220km.

► Sports Facilities

Athletes area characteristics:

The athletes will have their own area. This area includes:

BOATHOUSE | RESTROOMS & WC FACILITIES | LOUNGE AREA | ATHLETES SERVICES

All entrances to the competition will be free of charge. We will provide temporary structures for leisure. This will include entertainment, food and beverage kiosks, merchandise kiosks and other activities for the public to enjoy. We will try to attract as many people as possible and therefore we will use local and national media coverage such as radios, TV channels, press and media. A video signal of the races will be displayed in more than 30 plasma screens, around the Venue. For all those already been in Montemor before, in 2015 no boats will be kept inside the main building. We will have a big tent outside for this matter, in front of the water for all boats. This will increase the hangars capacity and conditions for all nations.

Spectators Services:

INFORMATION

The information will be set in 2 steps: outside the limits of the event, at different public locations and also at the main entrance of the venue in appropriated structures for the purpose.

MERCHANDISING

The merchandising will be set at the main entrance of the venue in appropriated structures for the purpose.

SANITARY FACILITIES

Will be temporary structures, placed in strategic locations and also public bathrooms at the main entrance. This includes handicap Toilets.

FOOD

This service will be assured by local cafe & restaurant and food structures rented to catering and drinks establishments. This will be located in the areas surrounding the public stands.



► Centre of High Performance

The Centre for High Performance Montemor-o-Velho [CAR], stands out for its importance nationwide. It is an anchor project with the capacity to generate synergies and commitment from both the public and the private sector, applying the strategic value of sport in the local development agenda.



The Building

The main building is close to the pier and the outside access.

The transfer of the boats, from the trailers park to the storage inside the venue and outside the hangars is made in a direct path, coordinated by the local staff.



This structure includes 16 hangars for teams (24x6m each), restaurant area, showers, bathrooms, gymnasium, and polyvalent rooms, which occupy the entire front of the Centre. a complete and brand new gymnasium will also be available to be used by all nations. This will have a controlled access policy.

Teams Area

There will be 15 hangars available for the teams that will be distributed according to the number of its elements. Your Federation hangar will be published a week before the race. Upon arrival, you will be able to find your country identified at each entrance.



ID Control and Polyox Control

The competitors can embark to the race from the 1st pier, where their boats, body numbers, boat numbers and accreditation cards are checked by ICF Officials.

1st Boat Control

All teams are requested to book the boat control upon arrival to the venue with chief official. After 1st boat control this structure will be converted into an athlete's lounge during all event.

Medical Centre

There will be several security entities working during the week of the Race at the venue.

Take note that the minimal services will be available for the training days.

The medical Centre will only be opened during the competition hours. The security Operations Control Centre will be the coordinator centre for all the medical and security teams.

Anti Doping will be held at the back of the Medical Centre. Selected competitors have to face doping control according to ICF regulations.

Info Point

The information Point for the team leaders is located in the competitor's area.

During the competition, volunteers in this point, will provide information not only about start lists and results but also about the event in general. This is also the place where you can deliver crew changes forms, etc...

A Plasma screen will be also available in this location with real time results and start lists.



► Centre of High Performance

Message Room

If your team's hangar is not enough, the organization will provide you an extra open space for your team massages and relax time. All equipments have to be brought by you.

Prize Giving Ceremony

This area is meant to reunite the competitors that will participate in the medal ceremony. This is the place where your athletes can change clothes and can prepare themselves for the ceremony. The access to this area is made directly from the 2nd boat control.

Free Weight

There will be a free scale, where you can weigh up your boats during the competition days.

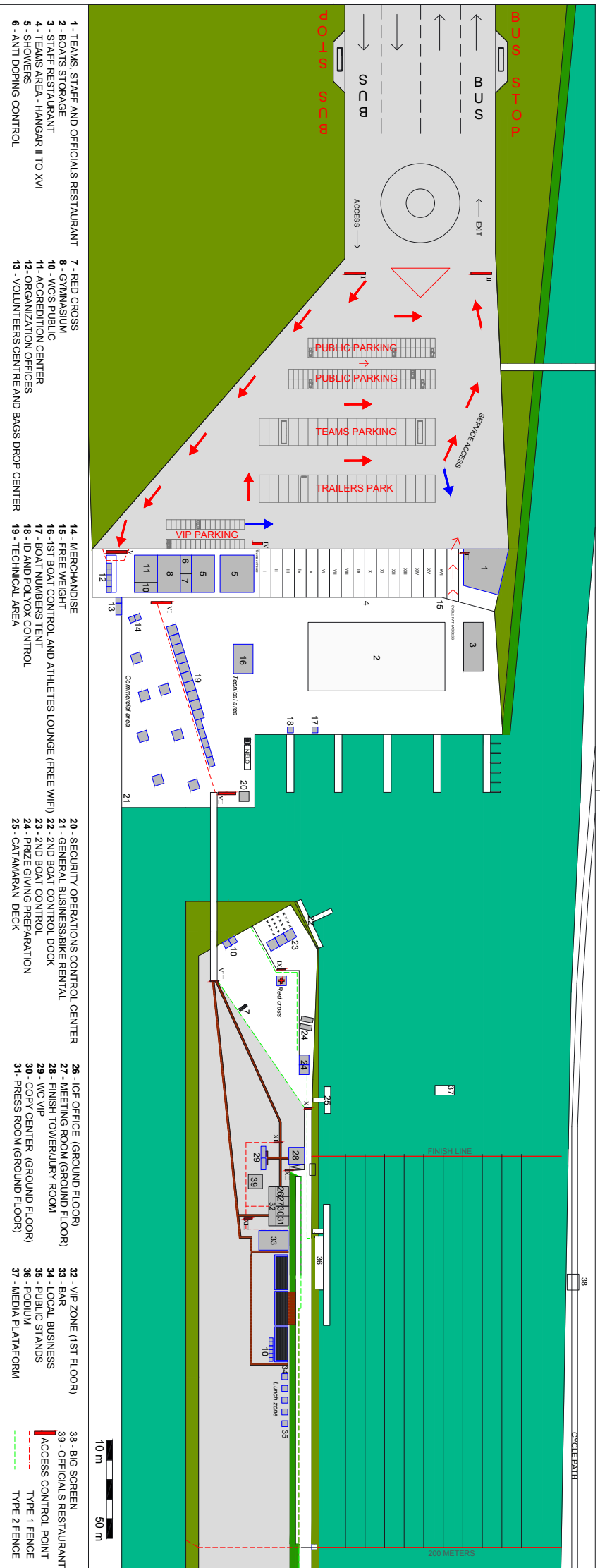
Accreditation

The Accreditation centre is located at the Venue Entrance. All participants will arrive directly to the Accreditation Centre. There will be two rooms for the accreditation. The first is dedicated to the finance department and the second is dedicated to the production of the accreditation cards and delivery of documents to the team's leader. Only the team leader needs to proceed to the accreditation desks to collect the accreditation cards and other objects for the team. Because many of the teams did not enter correct pictures of their members in the online system, the organization will need the presence of some athletes at the accreditation desk to be able take some pictures and to print the cards

In the layout below you can check the place of all the facilities prepared for the event.



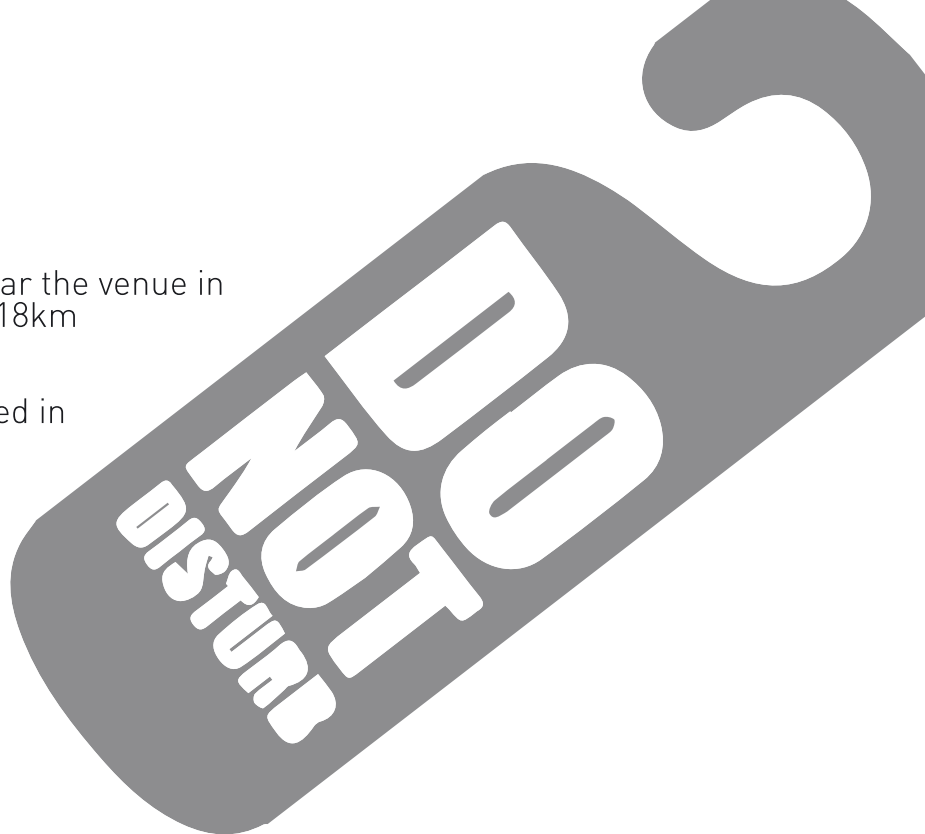
► Accommodation

This is the only hotel in Montemor-o-Velho and it has very limited capacity and it will be available specially for teams in pre-competition training camps.



Portuguese National Guard Training centre

It's a multi room (10 beds in each room) with shared bathrooms and division between men and woman(teams may choose to have men's and women all together, but bathrooms are separated). This accommodation is inside a military base in Figueira da Foz and with some special rules for all guests. Breakfast in a buffet style at the accommodation, Lunch and dinner at the venue.

There are some social facilities for teams inside the base, like bar and open exterior space.

There will be local policy at both venues to assure that everyone is safe and to guarantee that only authorized athletes can enter go into the athletes area, for example. All the athletes must wear their identity cards must show them at the venue entrance to prove that they are in the race.

The security plan will be practiced by the local security authorities: Portuguese National Guard, Police, Civil protection, fire brigade and Portuguese Red Cross.



► Anti-doping control

The Doping control will be provided according to the ICF standards, in partnership with the Nationals entities ADOP.

It will be located in specific room at the venue.



► Medical support

The medical centre will be divided into two places. One in the athletes' area and other one near the second boat control tent.

At the venue there will be two ambulances and paramedics that will follow the race on land and on the water as well.
